We also had a Pomeranian competing in Obedience - Novice B on Saturday. Jolvin's Spencer owned and trained by Thelma MacDonald. Spencer qualified with a score of 194 and was awarded the PCOC High in Trial Award. Spencer is a lovely boy and Thelma has done obedience for many years with several different Pomeranians.

Our Show chair, Bob Gibson was kept busy at ringside handing out goody bags to dogs as they left the ring as every dog entered received a bag full of "stuff". The bags themselves were fancy black bags provided by Iams and Bob got really creative and found a way to put the specialty logo on each one. 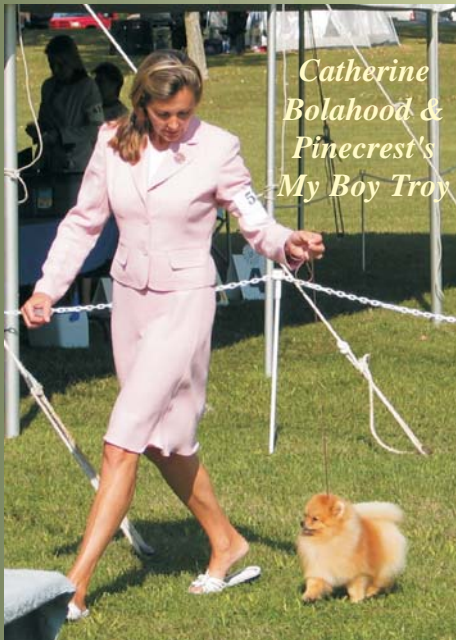
